A message from Malcolm

GOOGONG'S PROJECT DIRECTOR

The construction of Googong continues steadily as registration of subdivision Stage NH1A Stage 7B (77 lots) and NH1B 8A (61 lots) fast approaches. This brings the total number of completed lots in Googong North to 1,635 and works are underway on a further 89 lots in Neighbourhood 1A Stage 6C.

There are now around 1,000 homes occupied and a further 250 under construction in Googong –we've certainly come a long way!

Works are expected to commence on the first stage of Googong Central around May 2018.

This follows on from the approval of the Development Application this January, and further detailed designs and approvals. In preparation for this, we've commenced works to relocate the overhead power lines through this area to the edge of Old Cooma Road.

Works on upgrading the intersection of Old Cooma Road and Googong Road are planned to commence in February/March.

These works are expected to take about 6 months and once complete will provide a huge improvement to convenience and safety at this intersection. I ask that you please drive carefully and with patience whilst the construction works are underway.

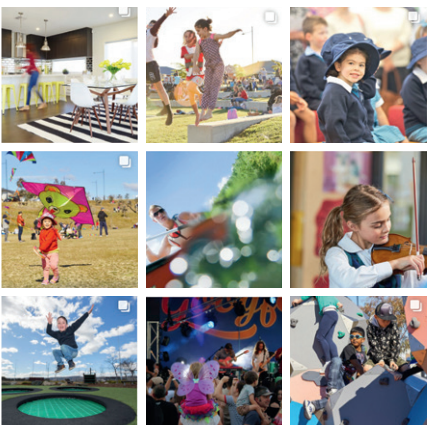
Similarly, we understand Council are working to finalise the design of the upgrade of Old Cooma Rd between Googong and Edwin Land Parkway and that they hope to commence works within the next few months. Again, this will be a great improvement to access to Googong but will involve some inevitable delays during construction.



The opening of Burbank's display home brings our display village to 18 homes – the biggest of its kind in the region.

GOOGONG NORTH VILLAGE CENTRE IS NEARLY HERE



WE'RE HAPPY TO ANNOUNCE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE GOOGONG NORTH VILLAGE CENTRE IS NEARING COMPLETION!

At this stage, we're looking at a late February completion date for the centre itself. That said, the businesses moving in will take a little longer to get up and running – we're expecting trading from late March or early April, subject to finalising agreements and the progress of the various retail fitouts.

The site's civil works and car parking is complete, while the verge works will be completed in the coming weeks. The residential units should be ready for occupation in April/May.

Our Place Childcare are putting the finishing touches to the landscaping and internal works, and will have a formal handover from the developers in February. They're expecting to welcome their first groups of mini-Googonians in early March (subject to final licensing).

The **IGA Supermarket** and liquor store commenced their fit out last month and are expected to complete this work towards the end of March. Final stocking and installation suggests an early April trading commencement.

Googong's park designers are determined to bring adventure back into play with Yerradhang Nguru (Gumnut Park) on Aprasia Avenue opposite the display village.

This brilliant fantasy space features giant gumnut-shaped climbing pods designed to challenge children's climbing skills and sense of adventure. There are even outdoor ping pong tables for the older kids, as well as undercover BBQ facilities.

This playground is one of more than 23 parks and playgrounds that will eventually be scattered throughout the township. The parks are just part of the \$90 million landscaping plan being implemented by Googong development partners Peet Limited and Mirvac over the life of the project. Almost a quarter of Googong will be dedicated to parks and open space.

Googong Common is our town's 'green lungs', stretching across Googong. This enormous park will house major indoor and outdoor sporting facilities, including eight playing fields, an indo or sports centre, tennis centre, netball courts as well as a large regional playground and community gardens.

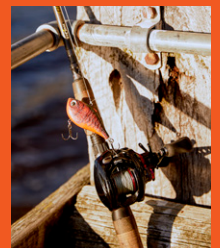
